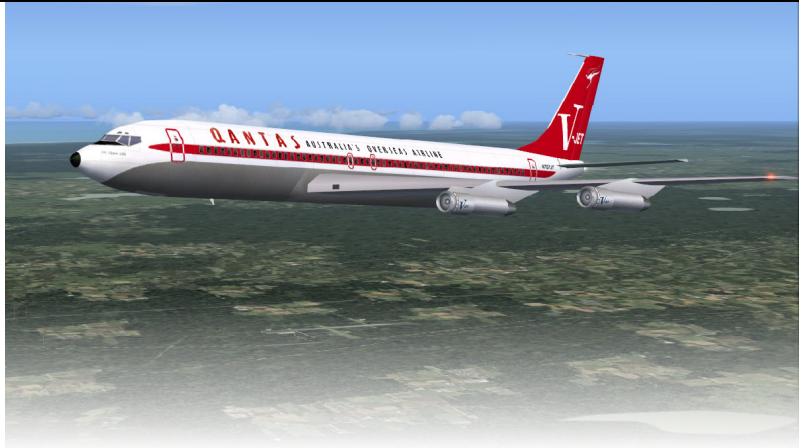


John Travolta AI Fleet Pack

Introduction

Thank you for downloading my file. This package includes the AI B707-320 model by Dee Waldron and AI Gulfstream G-IIIB by Henry Tomkiewicz repainted as the current fleet owned by John Travolta. Both models are included as permitted in the EULA from those packages. Thanks Dee and Henry for your great work.

I don't pretend to be a master repainter but since nobody else has done it I had to do it myself. The 707 Vjet is adapted from a paint created by Bob Hughes. The nice scenery of Greystone Airport by Derek and Brendan Webb (DBWsimGreystone05.zip at AVSIM) is required for this to work.

Installation

Download the Greystone scenery as mentioned above and install according to the instructions that came with that package. From the scenery folder of that package remove the "AF2_1FL.BGL" file to a backup location that is not activated in the simulator. Unzip the contents from my JT_Fleet package and place the "AF2_17FL_JT.bgl" in to your C:\Program Files\Microsoft Games\Flight Simulator 9\Addon Scenery\scenery folder. I had to modify the afcad in order for my package to work properly.

To install the aircraft place both the "AI_B707-320_JT" and "AI Gulfstream G-IIIB_N492JT" folders in to the C:\Program Files\Microsoft Games\Flight Simulator 9\Aircraft folder. Finally in order to see the planes at the airport place the "Traffic_Travolta_Vjet.bgl" file in to your C:\Program Files\Microsoft Games\Flight Simulator 9\Scenery\World\scenery folder. That's it for installation.

Important Notes

The flight plans are very simple. They are designed to have the planes sitting at their parked position by Mr. Travolta's house in Ocala Florida. So as not to be too boring the planes will take off to San Juan Puerto Rico (TJSJ) once a week. The 707 will do it on Monday at exactly 14:00 GMT and arrive at TJSJ a little more than 2 hours later. The Gulfstream will do the same flight with a touch more speed on Wednesday. I have

included the decompiled flight plans for those who know how to edit any way they wish to.

For those sticklers to reality out there I must mention that I used the 707-320 when in real life it is actually a 707-100B. If you look at photos the engines are different. Sorry but this is how I did it.
